Synonyms:Caspase recruitment domain-containing protein 18, ICEBERG, pseudo-ICE, UNQ5804.

Description:Caspase recruitment domain-containing protein 18, also known as CARD18, is a member of the deathdomain-fold superfamily that is induced by proinflammatory stimuli. It consists essentially only of a CARD, inhibits generation of IL-1b by interacting with caspase-1 and preventing association with RIP 2.

Form:Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCI buffer (pH 8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 10% glycerol, 0.1M NaCI

Molecular Weight: 12.3 kDa (110aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF

Storage:Can be stored at +4°C short term (1-2 weeks). For long term storage, aliquot and store at -20°C or -70°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing cycles.
